ALANTON Civic League 2023 Membership




Hello Alanton neighbors, it's time to pay your Dues! This is the Civic League's annual request to fund the Civic League. With Membership Dues, the Civic League is able to:

- Pay for Lawncare and Maintenance at the Entryway year-round.
- Pay for Irrigation repairs and maintenance to keep our gardens looking beautiful.
- Pay the electric bill to run the well pump and lighting.
- Pay the bills for Insurance, postage, print costs.

- Incidental or unplanned expenses like tree services.
- Plan and pay for events like the 4th of July Parade and the Spring Egg Hunt.

NEW PROJECT #2: Alanton Park Improvements

Located behind the Entryway wall, next to the Cape Henry School fence, is our "Alanton Park". Established 10 years ago when the pedestrian path was built, it is a partially hidden stretch of green space with a memorial bench, pollinator garden, and several Lilly and Daffodil beds. Residents walk through it every day coming and going from Mill Dam into Alanton. The Civic League would like to:

- Improve the existing beds- add plant material (Hostas in the shady beds, native sunloving plants in the sunny beds).
- Spruce-up the Pollinator Garden- Originally planted 10 years ago as a certified Monarch Waystation, the Milkweed has gone, and weeds have taken over. We'd like to plant new milkweed, clean out the invasive weeds, and add more native pollinating plants (Mountain Mint, Bee Balm, etc.).
